

## **Non-voting members**

- 1 Criteria for acceptance:
  - 1.1 Government or Government-linked
  - 1.2 Active in forensic science in the provision of education and training or in the conduct of research and development work
  - 1.3 Committed to contribute to AFSN. Examples of such activities are:
    - i. Actively participating in Workgroup/Committee activities as an Associate Member
    - ii. Collaborating with AFSN members in research and development work
    - iii. Conducting training or workshops for members in AFSN Annual Meeting & Symposium or Workgroup/Committee meetings
    - iv. Presenting papers in AFSN Annual Meeting & Symposium
- 2 Membership may be revoked by the AFSN Board if it no longer meets the criteria for membership.
